As Director of the National Center for Disability, Equity, and Intersectionality, she focuses her research on disability representation in media, disabled parenting rights, and disability ethics. Dr. Ayers transforms research into actionable change, advancing policy reforms and fostering inclusive healthcare through



an anti-ableist framework. Her work bridges the gap between academic research and real-world advocacy, creating pathways for equitable treatment and the celebration of human diversity.
